We are delighted to confirm that our upcoming Year 5 pupils will be taking part in a residential visit to The Winter Woodland High Ashurst Outdoor Education Centre in Dorking. The pupils will take part in a very exciting programme. This will include a number of team building tasks such as climbing and rope activities, woodland skills, orienteering and a night walk. We will leave school at approximately 10:30 am on Wednesday 15th November and return at approximately 3.00 pm on Friday 17th November. The first leg of our journey will take us to the Rykas Café car park, which is located near to the High Ashurst Centre. From here we will travel by minibus in order to reach the centre through the narrow lanes.

The cost of this visit is £145.00 per pupil and is payable via ParentPay by 1 November 2017. Formal consent can be made by ticking the box within ParentPay. Parents are able to pay the full amount in one payment or may pay by instalments. Please see the payment schedule below:

We are very keen for this visit to take place, however we should point out that there are no funds to cover the costs of pupils whose parents expect them to take part but who are unwilling to contribute. If you are in receipt of Income Support or Family Credit or if you have difficulty affording the above amount, please speak to Mrs Hart Dyke privately before Friday 3rd July 2017. If insufficient voluntary contributions are received the visit may have to be cancelled.

Although we have not yet had to do so on any previous occasion, I would like to point out that the school has a right to exclude a pupil from the visit either before or during it, if we consider that their behaviour or medical condition will jeopardise the success of the visit. If this occurs before the visit, every effort will be made to return any payments but no guarantee can be given, as payments may not be recoverable by the school.




We will write to you shortly with more details about clothing and medicines etc.
